

## **Trek : Deoriatal - Chopta – Chandrashila** ***(Grade: soft, Duration: 4 days)***

### **DAY 01: Arrive Delhi**

On arrival met our representative at the airport and transfer to the Hotel for overnight stay. If possible go for the day's sightseeing in Delhi.

### **DAY 02: Delhi – Rishikesh (224 kms, 6.5 hrs)**

After early breakfast drive to Rishikesh (*Rishikesh is a gateway to the important religious places of Badrinath, Gangotri, Kedarnath and Yamunotri, also called the Yoga capital, & river rafting centre of India*) via Haridwar. In the evening visit Laxman Jhoola, Triveni Ghat of world famous "Aarti" at the Ganges river banks. Dinner and overnight stay in hotel.

### **DAY 03: Rishikesh - Ukhimath (1100 mts/ 175 kms/7-8 hrs)**

In the morning after an early breakfast drive to Ukhimath via Devprayag and Rudraprayag. One can visit Devprayag (*Confluence of Alaknanda & Bhagirathi, from Devprayag the Holy Ganges started*), Rudraprayag (*Confluence of Alaknanda & Mandakini River*). Arrival at Ukhimath (*Ukhimath is the winter seat of Kedarnath, as well as the winter home of the priest who presides over his worship*) by evening, explore the area. Dinner and overnight stay in Tourist Rest House.

### **DAY 04: Ukhimath - Deoriatal (2438 mts/ 5 kms/4 hrs)**

In the morning you can see snow clapped Himalayan ranges. After breakfast start your trek to Deoriatal through dense forest of Rhododendron and lots of wild flowers and ferns. This lake has captivating surroundings with forest all around. The reflection of the mighty Chaukhamba peak in the lake creates a beautiful effect. Upon arrival at Deoriatal set out the tents for overnight stay.

### **DAY 05: Deoriatal - Sari - Chopta (1667 mts/3 kms/2 hrs)**

In the morning trek down to Sari village (3 kms) and from there on, drive to Chopta through dense forest and meadows. Its 22 kms drive from Sari Village. Upon arrival at Chopta set out & excursion the village. In the evening explore the magnificent view of the Himalayas. Chopta is known for its beautiful meadows and wide span. In early march there is possibility of seeing snow all around. Though trek may not require snow walking as such. Peaks all around will be snow laden, and weather will be pleasant in day time.. cold at night. Overnight in the tourist lodges of the village.

### **DAY 06: Chopta -Tungnath (3680 mts/14 kms/8 hrs) - Chandrashila - Chopta**

After an early breakfast trek to Tungnath with packed lunch. Tungnath is situated at the height of 3680 mts from the sea level the highest in India. The trek is three kms upward. Enroute you will find lush green meadows and you can see the entire range of snow clapped Himalayas. Upon arrival at Tungnath Temple and visit the temple. After relax one further one kms trek to Chandrashila peak. Later trek back to Chopta for dinner and overnight stay.

### **DAY 07: Chopta – Haridwar(245 kms/6.5 hrs drive)**

In the morning after breakfast drive to Haridwar (*Gateway to the Lord. One of the holiest Hindu pilgrim sites on the banks of the sacred river Ganga, famous for its ashrams & temples*).

Dinner and overnight stay in Hotel.

**DAY 08: Haridwar – Delhi (212 kms/ 6 hrs)**

Morning after early breakfast drive to Delhi. Upon arrival at Delhi, visit the famous Swaminarayan Temple( modern wonder), later transfer to the hotel for overnight stay .Dinner at nice hotel in Delhi.

**DAY 09: Delhi - Departure**

Morning Delhi local sightseeing tour including Red Fort, India Gate, President House etc. evening transfer to airport to catch flight for onward destination.
